ORSE collaborates with international actors and addresses global issues by:

- Networking with major global CSR membership organisations: CSR Europe (as a member) and BSR, in order to create and energize an international dialogue.
- Hosting foreign delegations from diverse countries (Algeria, Brazil, China, Japan, Morocco, Norway, South Korea, Tunisia...) to exchange views on issues, methods, projects.
- Translating in English most of ORSE's studies and reports in order to spread our work as widely as possible.
- Actively monitoring CSR for Instances of regulation such as OECD, ILO, Global Compact, European Commission, United Nations... for the public side, and GRI, ISO 26000... for the private side.
- Gathering on a single platform (www.reportingcsr.org) the most recognized CSR reporting initiatives taken by organizations. Available in English, this website was created in 2010 with support from public authorities and CSR stakeholder representatives. It assists companies in their CSR reporting initiatives by offering a large library (posting legislations by country, sector benchmarks...). It seeks to highlight local contacts able to assist organisations (for example local business networks).
